District 6 Museum: history and memories about a community of 60 000 people forcibly removed from their homes...



St George Cathedral: beautiful piece of architecture pointing at the Anglican heritage to find some peace and admire the fine Gabriel Loire windows.



The Company's garden: was established in 1652 to re-provision spice-sailing ships, a bit of green history in the heart of the city.



Robben Island: (In-)famous as a prison during the apartheid years, a ferry trip will take you there to take a glimpse at what prisoners like Nelson Mandela and Jacob Zuma endured.
